Dear Secretary Bose:

I write on behalf of Tres Palacios Gas Storage LLC (“Tres Palacios”) in response to the Commission’s September 20, 2007, “Order Issuing Certificates” issued in Docket Nos. CP07-90-000, CP07-91-000 and CP07-92-000,¹ which grants Tres Palacios authority to construct, own and operate certain underground natural gas storage and associated facilities in Matagorda and Wharton Counties, Texas, to render firm and interruptible storage services on an open-access basis pursuant to Part 284, Subpart G of the Commission’s Regulations at market-based rates, and to undertake certain facility construction, operation and abandonment under Part 157, Subpart F of the Commission’s Regulations.

In accordance with Section 157.20(a) of the Commission’s Regulations, 18 C.F.R. § 157.20(a) (2007), Tres Palacios hereby accepts the certificates of public convenience and necessity issued in the captioned proceedings on September 20, 2007. Tres Palacios commits to comply with all applicable regulations under the Natural Gas Act, including Sections 157.20(c), (e) and (f), 18 C.F.R. §§ 157.20(c), (e) and (f), as well as all conditions imposed by the Order.
